WE ARE A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE

Mafra, which has been reborn and recreated over time, has become a municipality with much to offer: built, intangible and natural heritage, as well as the local products that are transformed into excellent gastronomic delicacies.

The Royal Building of Mafra - Palace, Convent, Basilica, Cerco Garden and Tapada (Hunting Park) was inscribed in July of 2019 on the UNESCO World Heritage list. In addition to its heritage and architectural significance, this monument contains an excellent collection of baroque sculpture, an important assortment of Italian paintings, a library made up of 36,000 volumes, one of the largest sets of carillons in Europe, with 96 bells, as well as six historical organs.

USEFUL ADVICE

ERICEIRA

WE ARE A WORLD SURFING RESERVE

Ericeira is today a destination of excellence for wave and slide sports. The village, which is familiarized with tourism since the beginning of the 20th century, receives visitors of various nationalities, showing its streets and alleys with picturesque houses painted white and blue. The devotion of its people is present in the religious heritage, which has a vast collection of sacred art and architecture. This land of fishermen, continues to look at the ocean as one of its main forms of attraction.

Its coast was consecrated as a World Surfing Reserve in 2011, being the first in Europe and the second in the whole world to receive the distinction by Save the Waves Coalition. The Interpretation Centre of the Ericeira World Surfing Reserve, located in the centre of the town, hosts an interactive exhibition.


