

SEMINÁRIO – VI Encontro Internacional de Fogo Controlado VI International Prescribed Fire Meeting

Data: 08 de Maio 2023 Loja do Cidadão - Mafra

Context

The 2023 Flamework seminar will discuss and compare prescribed burning versus cultural fire. Cultural and traditional burning is a cultural fire practice used by First Nation people to improve the health of a region and its people, the "native" cultural burns focus on what needs to be burned to revitalize the land. This type of burning have a "social" license to operate, as they come from the community and the people.

On the other hand prescribed fire is a planned fire and is used to meet various management goals, some of which maybe the same as what the cultural burns aimed to do. A prescription is a set of conditions that considers the safety of the public and fire staff, weather, and probability of meeting the burn objectives.

Burning as practiced by 'prescription' in non-cultural and non-traditional contexts, such as Portugal and other places, has taken on the characteristics of prescription, safety, weather parameters, burn objectives, to meet regulatory requirements and address social or political concerns.

The 'prescription' is embedded in the practice through the timing, ignition patterns, season, conditions, and fuel state, all that have been built up over generations. It would be possible to 'extract' the "prescription" through consultation, observation and measuring the parameters.

The goals of the seminar are to compare both fire uses and to understand which technique the participants, from several parts of world, are applying to reach their land management objectives.
